

## How to Setup Google reCaptcha


To use Google reCaptcha on your website, you will need to have a Google reCaptcha API Key and Site Secret. You must have a Google account to get a Google reCaptcha API key/site secret. If you do not have a Google account you can get one here:

Get Your Google reCaptcha API Key/Site Secret - Use the following link to create a key/site secret <https://www.google.com/recaptcha/admin#list>

Enter a Label, we suggest using your domain name.





Use this in the HTML code your site serves to users.

**Secret key**  
Use this for communication between your site and Google. Be sure to keep it a secret.

6LenBFQUAAAAABV8qIaUihjizB8s\_erxiJHY1oss

**Step 1: Client side integration**

Paste this snippet before the closing `</head>` tag on your HTML template:

```
<script src='https://www.google.com/recaptcha/api.js'></script>
```

Paste this snippet at the end of the `<form>` where you want the reCAPTCHA widget to appear:

```
<div class="g-recaptcha" data-sitekey="6LenBFQUAAAAAErjCHtWo14yZjNlAnx9YAzVJsYc"></div>
```

**Step 2: Server side integration**

When your users submit the form where you integrated reCAPTCHA, you'll get as part of the payload a string with the name "g-recaptcha-response". In order to check whether Google has verified that user, send a POST request with these parameters:

URL: <https://www.google.com/recaptcha/api/siteverify>

<b>secret</b> (required)	6LenBFQUAAAAABV8qIaUihjizB8s_erxiJHY1oss
<b>response</b> (required)	The value of 'g-recaptcha-response'.
<b>remoteip</b>	The end user's ip address.
